and the life everlasting. Amen.

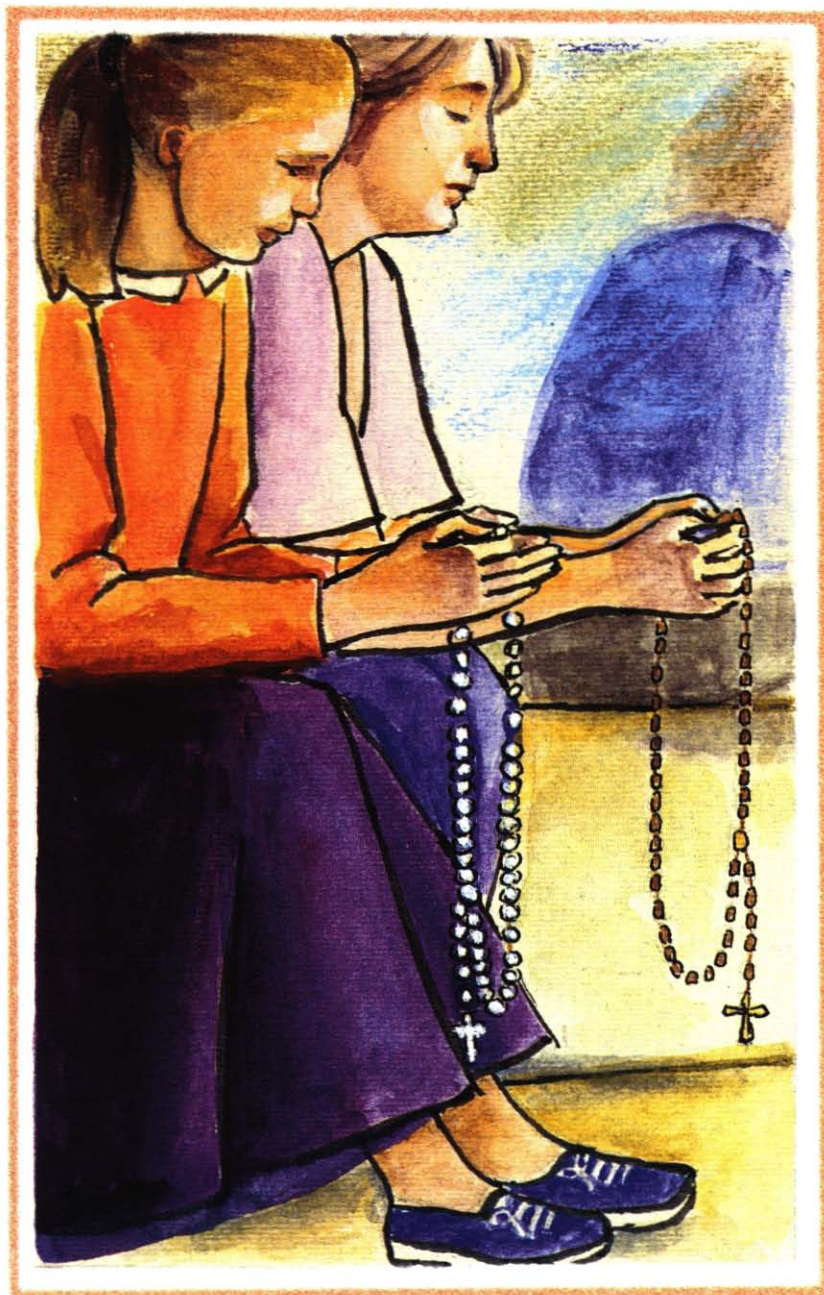

The Glorious Mysteries

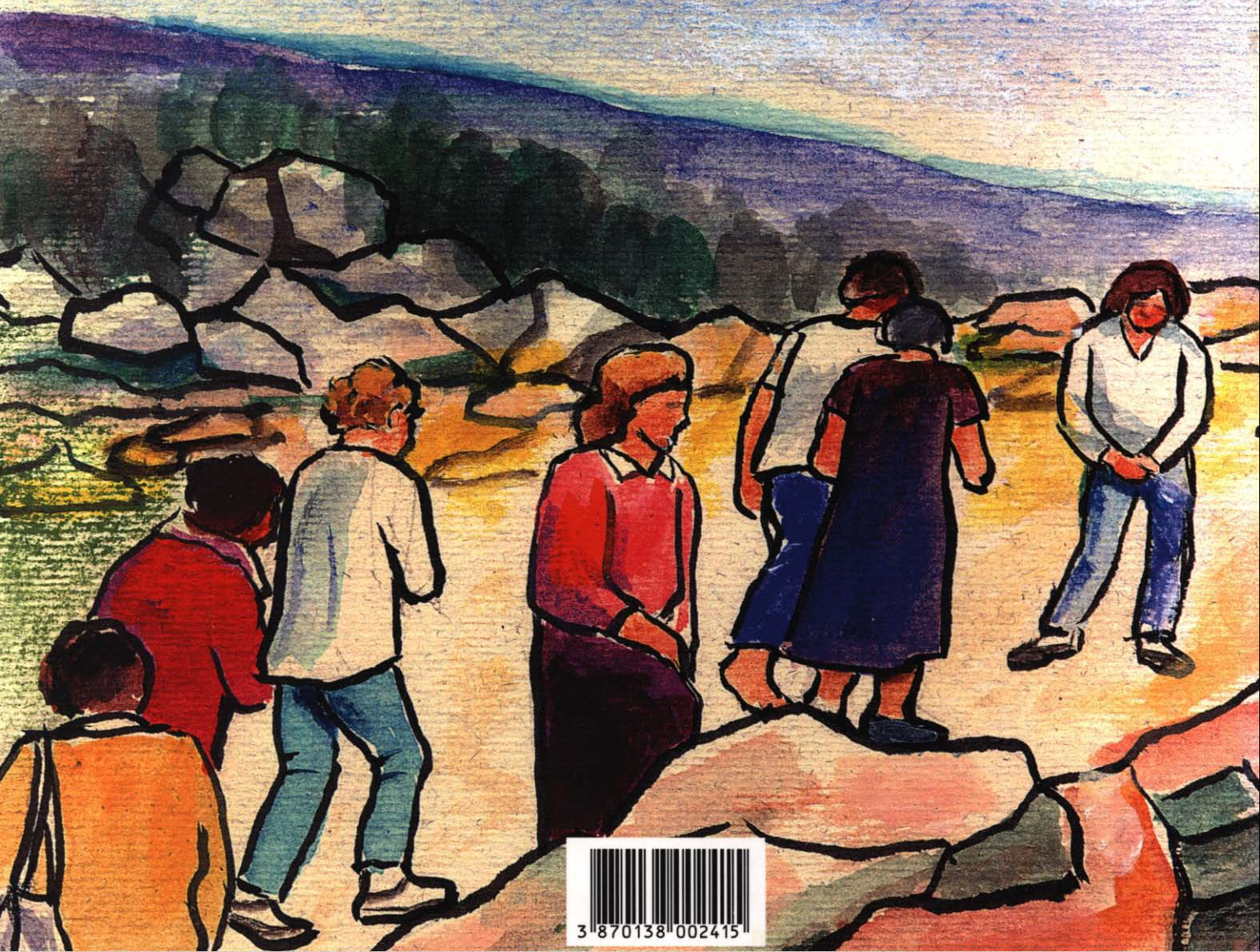
1. On the third Jesus rises from the dead.
